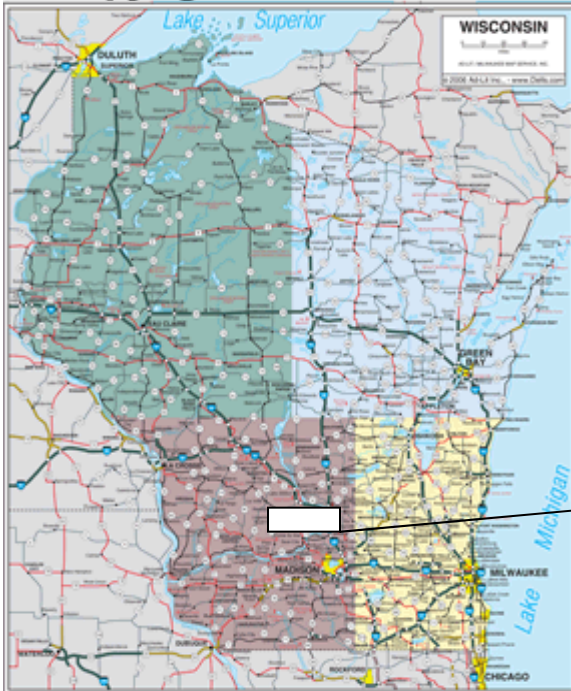

We have secured a block of rooms @ Great Wolf Lodge.

Group Rate - \$159.00 + tax per standard suite (up to 4 in a room)

To make reservations with Great Wolf Lodge for FamilyFEST by calling 1.800.559.WOLF and reference the Group Number 320451 with the Group Name WMU and arrival and departure dates. You may also make reservations online at www.greatwolflodge.com by clicking on the Wisconsin Dells property and clicking on Reservations. Type in the arrival date, departure date, and Group Number.

Great Wolf Lodge requires the first night room rate as a deposit. Advanced payments include first night lodging charges plus tax (per room). This is a non-refundable and non-cancelable when made within the 3-day cancellation period. A \$25.00 processing fee will be charged for rooms canceled prior to the 3-day cancellation period.

All balances are due and payable at check in.

Method of payment for individuals paying their own charges may use MasterCard, Visa, Discover, American Express, Cash, Traveler's Checks or Money Order. No personal checks are accepted.

Wisconsin Dells Facts/Information



Size of Community

Wisconsin Dells, as a destination, is comprised primarily of the City of Wisconsin Dells and the Village of Lake Delton. Totaling just over 19 square miles, this destination has 5,184 permanent residents, but can host over 50,000 guests per day.

Visitor Count

The Dells welcomes some 3 million visitors annually. During peak periods, it hosts 55,000 visitors per day.

Waterpark Statistics

There are more than 20 indoor and outdoor waterparks and 200+ waterslides, requiring approximately 16 million gallons of water.

Restaurants

Foodies delight in the 80+ choices, from classic steakhouses to vegetarian to ethnic.

Average Temperature

In the spring, temperatures average 45 degrees. In summer the average temperature is 73 degrees, although temperatures can reach into the 90's or even close to 100. In fall, the temperature cools to about 50 degrees. Winter temperatures hover around the 20 degree mark, sometimes dropping below zero, with annual snowfall averaging 30 inches. Inside the waterparks, it's always a balmy 85 degrees.

Driving Distances

Wisconsin Dells is centrally located in the Midwest - putting you at the center of everything. Mileage from major cities:

- Chicago, Illinois—188
- Minneapolis, Minnesota—233
- Detroit, Michigan—466 via ferry route or 680 via Mackinaw
- St. Louis, Missouri—417

There are airports in Madison, Milwaukee, Chicago and Minneapolis. By car, take Interstate 90/94. Greyhound and Amtrak also have service to the area.
