Howdy, cowgirl! Grab your hat and boots. This bolo tie is the perfect addition to your cowgirl outfit.

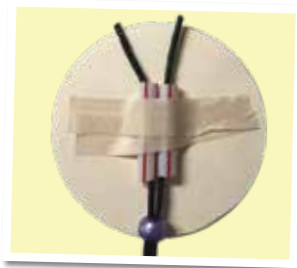

## WHAT YOU DO:

1. Trace the rim of a juice glass or other 2-inch circle onto card stock. Cut out the circle.
2. Draw the head of a horse or a star in the center of the circle. Decorate the edges of the circle with gem stickers or colorful shapes.
3. Cut two 1-inch pieces from the straw. Tape the pieces of straw side by side on the center of the back of the circle.
4. Lace each end of the cord through one of the straw pieces. Make sure the loop is at the top!
5. Lace both ends of the cord through one pony bead.
6. Add two or three beads to the bottom of each cord. Tie a knot at each end to hold the beads.
7. Slide the circle up and down the cord to make the bolo tie fit around your neck. The pony bead will help hold the circle in place.
