

Prayerwalk for Salt Lake City

The Kerns are missionaries who live in Salt Lake City, Utah. At each of these prayerwalk stops, read about and pray for the Kerns.

STOP 1: Prayer is necessary for every time a Christian tries to share the gospel. Spiritual warfare (attack from the devil) is real. The Kerns ask God to equip them with the full armor of God so they can stand against Satan (Ephesians 6:10–18). If Satan knows a soul may be won to Christ, he will look for ways to stop that opportunity. The Kerns pray before, during, and after meeting with someone. *Pray for God to lead as the Kerns face spiritual warfare.*

STOP 2: "God does not just call pastors. He calls many workers to the field. We pray for God to send anyone to Utah who has a love for Him and a love to see people come to Christ." Pray that new church planters will come to Utah.

STOP 3: "Our church planters leave family and friends to live in a place where they may not see another believer their entire week, except in church meetings." *Pray that new churches will continue to see people come to Christ.*

STOP 4: "The challenge of being an evangelical Christian in Utah is to see the difference between faith in the God of the Bible and faith in a man-made god. It is important to have the correct definitions of God, Jesus, the Holy Spirit, and Scripture. [Mormons use the same words but have different meanings for them.] Many people in Utah put their trust in people and earthly things. We try to show them that faith in God does not depend on people or the things we own." *Pray that the Kerns' friendships with people outside of the Christian faith will grow stronger.*

STOP 5: "We pray for God to send many kinds of workers to the field. God may be calling someone to move to Utah just to be a faithful church member who can share Christ with their neighbors or where they work." *Pray for more workers to come to Salt Lake City, including faithful church members.*
